## HANDS-ON WORKSHOP- CURRICULUM FRAMING

## **Report:**

Bharati Vidyapeeth was founded by former Chancellor Hon'ble Dr Patangrao Kadam Saheb. Under the guidance of Pro Vice Chancellor Bharati Vidyapeeth Dr Vishwajeet Kadam sir and Executive Director Bharati Vidyapeth Health Sciences Dr Asmita Tai Jagtap ma'am, several institutes under the University have been known to conduct several Faculty Development Programs. BVDU's School of Physiotherapy, Pune has taken initiative to organise this Faculty Development Program on 'Hands on Workshop on Curriculum Framing'
